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## New features

### API mass approval and deletion of sensors

Using XML API, you can now approve or delete single sensor or multiple sensors.

### API bulk update of vPatch rules

Using XML API, you can now update the **Terminate Session** setting on one or multiple rules.

### API bulk update of Network Monitoring setting and Advanced Parameters

Using XML API, you can now set **Network Monitoring** on single or multiple sensors or databases. You can also set **Advance Parameters** for one or multiple databases.
