This release is cumulative and contains all fixes released through the hotfixes for McAfee® Endpoint Security for Mac 10.2.1.

McAfee® ePolicy Orchestrator® (McAfee® ePO™) DAT compliance query using McAfee® Endpoint Security extensions	Allows you to create and run a McAfee ePO query to check the DAT compliance status on Mac systems based on the DAT creation date.
Support for McAfee Anti-Malware Engine 5900	Packaged with the latest McAfee Engine 5900.

Resolved issues

Reference	Issue description
1165833	The McAfee Agent Status Monitor now displays the correct McAfee® Agent version on Mac OS 10.12.x systems.
1174597	When you disable the Enable Default Client Update task schedule from the McAfee Endpoint Security Common Policy, the local update schedule is now disabled.
1111494	McAfee Endpoint Security for Mac now starts successfully, even if a system contains a group with ID 499.
1169745	An ICMP rule that allows all message types is now enforced successfully on Mac systems.
1170735	When you restart the client Mac after a policy enforcement, the intermittent issues such as DAT update, scanning related failures no longer occur.
1170681	After rebooting, McAfee Endpoint Security for Mac now works normally, even when an imported Common Policy is enforced with the Client Interface Mode and Uninstallation password options enabled.
1179723	The software is upgraded successfully even if the on-demand scanning is running in the background.
1077269, 1166515	After installation, the software no longer generates unwanted Access Protection violation events for Threat Prevention, Web Control, and Firewall files.
